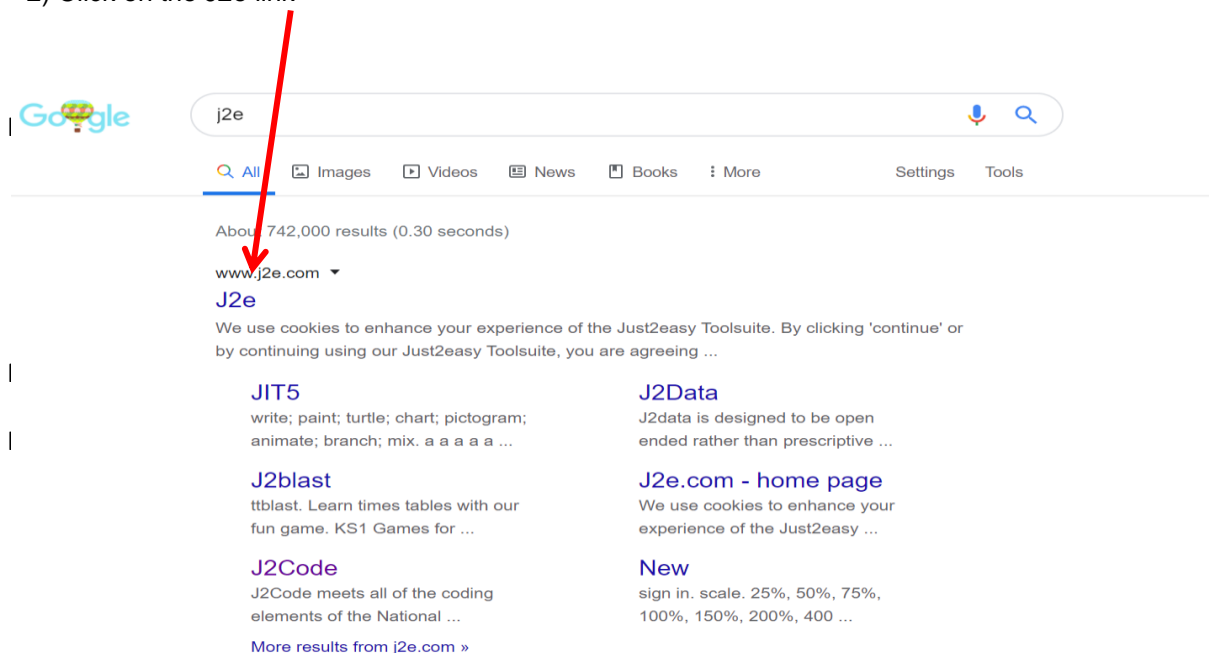
### Online home learning

Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you so much for your support and understanding during this difficult time. The last couple of weeks have been really difficult for all concerned and your cooperation has been greatly appreciated. In order to continue to support the children's learning, we have set up an online home learning area. Every week new learning tasks will be uploaded onto the online programme J2e for all pupils to access (Nursery to Year 6). Please find instructions below how to access the online learning.

### Accessing J2e from home:

- 1) Google J2e
- 2) Click on the J2e link



- 3) Type into the school box: Biggin
- 4) Type in child username which is your child's first name followed by a space and the first letter of their last name; for example: donald d
- 5) password: This has been sent to your mobile number
- 6) click sign in





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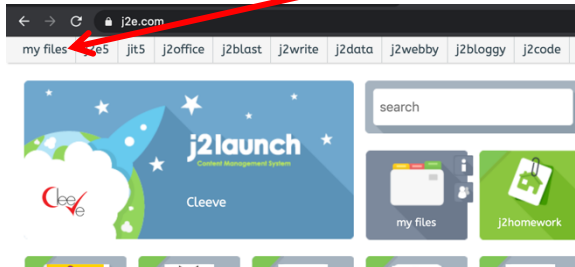
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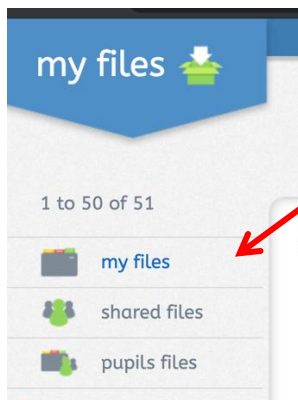
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7) Once you are logged in click 'My Files'



8) To find the work that has been set click 'Shared Files'



Children will also be set tasks through the homework tab.



Here you will get a



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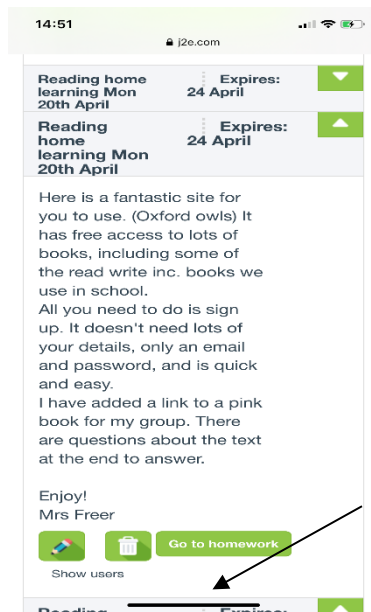
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description of the activity set and links to any websites or resources that maybe required. We will direct you to work in shared files here too.



If a website link has been given all you need to do is click on the 'go to homework button'.

On the homework section you can let your teachers know that you have completed any of the tasks set. You do this by clicking 'mark complete'.

Teachers will be able to see your work and comment on it. You will be able to respond and keep in touch with your teacher.

The work set will change every Monday. Please note that work will not be set over the Easter holidays.

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### How to Support home learning

Please find below some tips regarding Home Learning that may be useful to your family. We do not expect parents to become teachers or children to stick to a regimented routine. You, as parents, need to decide what the best formula for your child is.

To consider:

- Create and stick to a routine if you can. This is what children are used to. For example, eat breakfast at the same time and make sure they are dressed before starting the 'school' day – avoid staying in pyjamas!
- If you have more than one child at home, consider combining their timetables. For example, they might exercise and do maths together – see what works for your household.
- Designate a working space if possible.
- Make time for exercise and breaks throughout the day. Start each morning with a PE lesson at 9am with Joe Wicks!
- If you have a garden, use it regularly. If you don't, try to get out once a day as permitted by the government (households can be together outdoors but 2 metres apart from others.)
- Ask your children to write in a diary what they did each day.
